### A Vital Mississauga, Now and Tomorrow

Our community is a strong and vital place to live, learn, play and work. We are even stronger when people commit to and connect with each other. When we work together, we can address local needs, face challenges and inspire others to realize their potential. When we pool our talents and resources, we can achieve more and enhance our community's resilience.

For ninety years, the community foundation model has offered the motivation and the means for ordinary Canadians to invest locally, to align their philanthropic vision with community needs and to multiply the impact of a single gift by pooling funds together. Today there are over 190 community foundations across Canada joined by our strong, national membership organization, Community Foundations of Canada.

Since 2001, The Community Foundation of Mississauga has provided over \$4 million in grants to over 300 local programs and projects, providing financial support that sustains a strong and vibrant community. We have been the recipient of some of the largest philanthropic gifts in Mississauga but we are also known for our strength in supporting and maximizing the impact of gifts of a more



modest size. Individual and organizational donors have come to rely on the Community Foundation of Mississauga to provide them with the resources, knowledge and options they need to create their charitable legacy.

Our Foundation has responded to the Governor General's challenge by launching our Smart & Caring Communities campaign. Through this campaign, donors will be supporting a critical moment in the foundation's history as we build a culture of involvement, engagement and collaboration, today and for generations to come.

To create sustainable support for community needs in Mississauga by building partnerships with donors and stakeholders who establish endowed and other related funds, to maximize our community impact by ensuring that we identify and understand community needs, and to invest in solutions.

## Our Financial Model: A Strong Foundation

The Community Foundation of Mississauga's **Smart & Caring Communities** campaign operates within our existing overarching fund structure; immediate programming needs are supported by short and long term flow-through funds while ongoing capacity building initiatives are fueled by the income generated by the endowed funds.

The endowed funds are professionally managed. They are continuously monitored through the rigorous oversight of both our Investment Committee made up of industry professionals and ultimately, our Board of Directors. The Board is comprised of volunteers who represent a broad cross section of business know-how underscored by a passion for building community.

The **Smart & Caring Communities** campaign will generate \$1 million to be pooled within our endowed fund, meaning that costs are minimized and the impact of each gift is maximized. The capital of each contribution is added to the endowment and will generate investment income for sustainable grant-making.

As with all of the Community Foundation of Mississauga funds, the **Smart & Caring Communities** funds will be pooled with other endowed funds to generate the best in investment management expertise at the lowest possible cost. The Foundation is committed to transparency and accountability; we report annually to fundholders and make financial documents readily available on our website.



The **Smart & Caring Communities** movement is more than a series of initiatives, more than an expansion of current successes. It means basing priorities in evidence and investing in solutions that are long-term and sustainable. There is no better investment that we can make, no greater legacy than that of preparing our children and youth for the future. Our children deserve no less.

The evidence tells us that our community needs to invest in the well-being of our children. Recent data shows that one in five children lives in poverty in our community. Yet the chronic underfunding of programs and services for children and their families in Mississauga (as part of the Region of Peel) continues. This means that too many of our children struggle to get the best possible start, to have access to programs and services when they need them. For children with mental health needs, wait times for support are too long.

We also know that youth unemployment continues to present concerns. In 2010 the youth unemployment rate in Mississauga (as part of the Region of Peel) had risen to 21 per cent, up from 19.6 per cent in 2009 and 13.2 in 2008. Improving youth access to employment helps to ameliorate subsequent issues such as social unrest and intractable poverty.

As a community we want the best for all of our children. This means great health care services and equipment here at home, safe and clean parks, opportunities to participate in sports and recreational programs, access to learning that helps build positive outcomes and so much more.

Focusing on children is an investment in the future because a stable society and a strong economy ultimately depend on a healthy, well-educated population.
